


Jun 3D Rotorua Multisport Festival

When Matariki reappears in our dawn skies around June or July each year, it heralds the start of te Tau Hou Māori - the Māori New Year. There will be a wide range of Rotorua events for all the family to celebrate this special time of year.





Rotorua's geothermal water is known as 'Waiariki' or 'water of the gods'. The soothing water, mineral rich muds, traditional massage and indigenous herbs all play a special role in Rotorua's unique offerings. From a relaxing soak through to marvelling at geothermal wonders - there's something for all in Rotorua.



Hot Water Beach

Situated on Lake Tarawera, Hot Water Beach is accessible by both trail and boat. The beach provides bathing opportunities in the warm waters of Te Rata Bay, fed by a naturally heated hot stream. Lakeside Camping is also available at Hot Water Beach (check out the DOC website).



Polynesian Spa

Declared one of the top 10 day spas on the planet by Conde Nast, this iconic complex offers hot mineral bathing with four different areas to choose from and a menu of soothing massage and spa treatments.



Waikite Valley

Visit Waikite Valley Thermal Pools to experience the 'Living Waters' of the Te Manaroa Spring - the largest single source of boiling water in New Zealand. The water cascades into the main settlers pool, the toddlers beach, the sit 'n' soak pool and the luxurious garden and pergola pools.



Waimangu Volcanic Valley

Experience a unique geothermal and ecotourism attraction on foot and by water to discover the world's youngest geothermal system. Be sure to venture out on Lake Rotomahana - where you can learn the history of the 1886 Tarawera eruption.





Te Puia

Põhutu Geyser at Te Puia is the largest active geyser in the Southern Hemisphere. Enjoy watching Põhutu Geyser erupt once or twice every hour, sometimes reaching heights of 30 metres. Põhutu means constant splashing in Māori.



Blue Baths

Mixed bathing in liquid light. Such was the promise of pleasure used to entice visitors to Rotorua's Blue Baths in the 1930's, the first venue to daringly offer mixed bathing in New Zealand. The Juvenile Pool sits at 30°C whilst the two hot soak pools vary between 37°C and 42°C.



QE Health

Bathing in hot mineral water for health benefits and pleasure has been practiced for centuries. The alkaline and sulphurous water at QE Health from the Rachel Spring is renowned for its softening effects on the skin and its relaxing properties.



Hells Gate

Check out New Zealand's most active geothermal attraction, with the biggest mud volcano in the country and the largest hot waterfall in the Southern Hemisphere. Be sure to soak in the geothermal mud baths which help to remove excess oils, leaving your skin feeling soft and smooth.



Whakarewarewa Living Māori Village

Discover the unique lifestyle and traditions at Whakarewarewa Living Māori Village. Set within a landscape of erupting geothermal activity, thermal hot springs and bubbling mud, the village people live in harmony with Mother Nature in this unique environment.



Rotorua is a great place to get away for that fun filled family weekend. Explore the sparkling waters and hidden gems of picturesque Lake Rotoiti from the comfort of a 53-foot, luxury catamaran. Swim in caves, soak in the lake-edge thermal hot pools or just relax and enjoy a delicious BBO lunch.





Lake Tikitapu - The Blue Lake

This is a popular spot for water sports and there's also a beautiful track (5.5km) through native bush around the lake edge. For those wanting a longer walk, continue on and enjoy the Green Lake loop.



The Redwoods

Just 5 minutes from downtown Rotorua, experience the beauty of a stroll through the grove of towering Californian Redwood trees, dedicated to the memory of the men of the New Zealand Forest Service who died in the two World Wars.



Mountain biking

Whakarewarewa Forest boasts a huge range of trails from grades 1 to 5. It's no wonder that the International Mountain Biking Association recognises Rotorua as one of only six gold level ride centres in the world!



Lake Okareka Boardwalk

An easy 5km return trail that winds around the lake through native trees and shrubs before entering the wetlands. Hang out in the birdwatching hide to observe the range of water birds who call the wetlands home.



Rotorua Canopy Tours

Experience the native forest through a series of bridges, ziplines, treetop platforms and trails. This 3 hour wilderness adventure mixes fun, education and conservation into a once in a lifetime experience.








